



#### This is the statement:

No matter your age, race, nationality, political affiliation, documentation status, gender, sexual orientation, disability, and spiritual/religious background, you are welcome here.


In alignment with the New England Annual Conference's actions in 2016 and 2019 and the 2022 New England Declaration, we affirm people of all genders and sexualities in their callings to singleness or marriage, lay or ordained ministry of any kind, and the baptism of their children.

The Church Council agreed on these steps forward:


\*The statement of inclusion will be included in the Church Bulletin and on our Leominster UMC website.

\*The church will provide space for LGBTQ+ community events and events for family, friends and allies of LGBTQ+ people

\*A horizontal sign of rainbow colors that says "All are Welcome" will be added to our large sign at the front of the church to demonstrate to those who recognize the symbolism that they will be welcome at LUMC.
